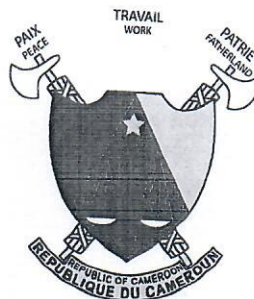

Within the framework of the on-going debt confirmation operation, the Minister of Finance hereby recalls that in view of the relatively low participation of creditors in producing the additional documents required for the processing of their pre-selected files, an appropriate mechanism has been put in place in the premises of his ministry in Yaoundé, Bloc A, in order to allow latecomers to catch up.

With this in mind, the deadline for the operation is extended to **December 9, 2022 at 3 p.m.**, after which time claims that would not have been confirmed will be considered and declared definitively rejected. The documents required are and remain :

1. 01 certified copy of the ID card of the person in charge of depositing the file;
2. 01 copy of the taxpayer card of the structure that performed the service concerned;
3. 01 copy of the event giving rise to the debt (Purchase order, Letter of order, Contract, Agreement, Decision, Order, etc.);
4. 01 copy of the acceptance report or the certificate of service performed or effective presence, as the case may be;
5. the final invoice(s) or payment certificate(s) of the debt or the validated reports as the case may be;
6. 01 copy authenticated before a notary of the deed mandating the person responsible for submitting the file(s), accompanied by the deed of creation of the structure concerned (case of mandated person) or 01 copy of the deed creating the structure (case of person owning the structure).

The lists of creditors concerned and the files that have been definitively rejected can be consulted at the Regional Finance Control offices, as well as on the websites www.minfi.gov.cm and www.dgb.cm.

The Minister of Finance hereby reminds all the rigour deployed for the success of this operation and warns any bad intentioned person, tempted with fraudulent actions to claim fictitious debts from the State.
